



MARI


Mari is a monarch butterfly. She likes flowers, traveling and spending time with her best friend, Humfrey. She's very kind and patient.

































































































































































CHRYSALIS FACTS!



- A monarch can stay in its chrysalis from 9 to 14 days!
- When a caterpillar goes into a chrysalis, it turns into goo! The goo then re-forms as a butterfly.
- Before a caterpillar
 becomes a chrysalis, it
 hangs upside-down.
 Its body forms a shape that
 looks like the letter J.
- After a few days, you can see the butterfly through the chrysalis.
- A monarch chrysalis starts out green with little gold spots.




WHAT CHANGES CAN YOU FIND?


Next, set your paper aside, and then come back later. Draw the same thing again! What changed? Did the flower close? Did the shadow change? Did the bug leave?!

Mari's Change


Mari is changing and Humfrey doesn't understand it. But like a good friend, he sticks by her – even if it means she might never be the same again.

The leaves are changing, the days are shorter, and Humfrey is very worried!






MARI & HUMFREY: WORLD OF DIFFERENCE
